Lucílle writes...

The season of Lent is upon us. According to Wikipedia Lent is: the solemn

Christian religious observance in the liturgical year in preparation for Easter. It echoes the 40 days Jesus spent fasting in the desert and enduring temptation by Satan according to the gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke before the beginning of his public ministry.

This accords more or less with how I thought of Lent until recently. It is a time when do not have flowers in the church, do not sing Alleluia, give up something we particularly enjoy, like chocolate, in order to focus on our relationship with God and spend more time studying the bible and praying. In short, we should be quiet and reflective and deny ourselves things that give us pleasure.

A recent conversation made me re-think my views on Lent. The bible did not help much as Lent is not mentioned. However, I did find an online definition from "Notes from Catholic Bishops Conference": Lent is a joyful season in which we prepare to celebrate the Paschal Mystery with mind and heart renewed".

Jesus certainly told us not to fast with dismal faces "like the hypocrites". His preaching also emphasised the need to hold our relationship with God above all material things. This means that we should not value anything more than God which may well necessitate re-evaluating our priorities from time to time!

Thus and therefore, if by our Lenten reflection we can deepen our relationship with God we will be blessed with joy in our loves. By that token our journey through Lent will be a happy and joyful one.

Lord, teach us how to pray during Lent with shining faces, glad hearts and the happiness that comes from knowing that you are our Lord and God. Amen
